### CONDITIONS OF USE:

- Rosewood Showgrounds Camping Facility is co-managed with the Lions Club of Rosewood Inc.
- The PERMIT (itinerary booking) NUMBER must be displayed at all times on the vehicle dashboard and camping accommodation where applicable.
- Fees must be paid in advance prior to arrival and before setting up onsite.
- Maximum of 6 people permitted per campsite.
- Maximum length of stay is 14 consecutive nights regardless of number of bookings within any 30-day period.
- Check out no later than 11am, Check in is after 12pm.
- No more than one vehicle with trailer is permitted per campsite.
- Fireworks or naked flames are prohibited.
- Plants, animals, natural or cultural resources must not be disturbed or damaged.
- Wildlife must not be fed, or food left out which may be scavenged.
- Council property must be left clean and tidy and undamaged, (including the removal of all rubbish and food scraps from the camp kitchen area.

- All rubbish must be removed on departure and placed in rubbish bins provided. Rubbish must not be buried or left behind.
- The permit holder must not create noise that in an authorised officer's opinion may be a nuisance to surrounding properties or disturb another person's enjoyment of the area; or likely to disturb another person's enjoyment of the area.
- Horses are not permitted within the campground area.
- Domestic animals other than guide/ service dogs are not permitted. Dogs must be on a leash at all times (no bungy or stretch leads, max. 1.5m length) and are not permitted in camp kitchen, showers, or toilet areas. You must pick up after your pet. No aggressive pets allowed.
- Strictly no smoking in toilet, showers, or camp kitchen areas.
- Vehicles must not be driven in the campgrounds after 10.00pm.
- Vehicles are only permitted on camp sites designated roads and car park areas.
- Nails, ropes, or similar fixings must not be used on vegetation or Council infrastructure.
- Sewerage from caravans/campervans must not be released at the campground except at designated dump point.
- Ipswich City Council must be notified as soon as practicable of any loss of or damage to Council property.
- Costs associated with Emergency Services, Security or Duty Officer callouts, cleaning or repairs will be the responsibility of the Permit Holder where an act or omission on their behalf has caused that to occur.
- Abusive and improper behaviour by permit holders, campers, and visitors will not be tolerated and may result in eviction off the campgrounds.
